- v) The DTA shall send the status report about the scheme in terms of Physical/Financial Progress made during the current financial year 2018-19 to the Administrative Department.
- vi) The funds shall be utilized for execution of the scheme strictly as per originally approved components.

- vii) The funds are utilized exclusively for the purpose for which these are released without creating any liability for future. No diversion of funds in any case is allowed without prior approval of the Tribal Affairs Department;
- viii) The other conditions shall remain the same as enumerated in the Government Order No. 554-FD of 2018 dated: 27-12-2018 issued by State Finance Department.


